

NEW AAH MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS

We are pleased to announce a new and improved AAH membership scheme, which will take effect from next year. In response to feedback from members, and ongoing membership developments, we have simplified and streamlined membership options.

Below is an overview of what will be happening and how it will all work. Further details and instructions will appear at www.aah.org.uk/membership and in the October issue of *Bulletin*.

What will be happening to membership subs?

From 2009, AAH membership will be separate from membership subscriptions to *Art History* and *The Art Book*. The AAH office will provide more streamlined membership-only options, whilst Wiley-Blackwell publishers will manage discounted membership subscriptions.

Why make these changes?

This new membership scheme is intended to allow members much more choice and flexibility with their membership, and to enable the introduction of new membership benefits, such as online access to publications. The only difference will be that members wishing to have discounted subscriptions to AAH publications will need to join/renew their membership and then set-up a subscription direct with Wiley-Blackwell.

The cost of separate membership and subscriptions for 2009 will be on a par with the combined membership fees currently in place for 2008.

At the moment there are many different membership options available to members, but this huge array has proved confusing and unwieldy. These changes have also allowed us to improve and expand upon existing membership benefits. For instance, members will continue to receive significant discounts on AAH publications, including receiving **up to a 75% discount on *Art History* journal and *The Art Book* magazine**, essentially giving members AAH publications at cost value. In addition, the new scheme will now make it possible for members to gain online access to both publications, which is something that the AAH has not been able to offer before.

The new scheme will offer members, and potential members the following:

- ◆ more straightforward and clearer membership options
- ◆ the option to choose to whether or not to subscribe to AAH publications, rather than *Art History* or *The Art Book* being automatically included with membership
- ◆ additional online access to *Art History* and *The Art Book*
- ◆ more choice and flexibility with membership
- ◆ access to the members-only area of website
- ◆ improved online services and e-communications

What will change and what will remain the same with membership?

Joining or renewing AAH membership will continue to take place online or via post, as usual. Subscribing to discounted AAH publications will be a quick and easy process that will probably take place online via a link on the AAH website. What's more, **the cost of the new split membership and subscriptions will be comparable with the previous combined membership options**. All members will continue to receive *Bulletin* and *e-Bulletin* as usual. New and existing membership options will remain in place (see right).

The new process will be more user friendly, and step-by-step instructions will be made available to members in *Bulletin* and on the AAH website in due course.
